
Pinterest is a great place to get ideas on seasonal clothing trends, as well as how to organize your layered look for work, home and around town.

- Purchase plywood before hurricane season it can be in short supply when a storm is approaching.
- Cut plywood sheets to size before hurricane season to reduce last minute preparations.
- Trim or remove damaged trees and limbs around your home.
- Secure loose rain gutters and clear any clogged areas of debris.
- Prepare an inventory list and store it in a safe location.
